Breakfast Club and Wraparound Care (After School Childcare)

We are now accepting bookings for our Breakfast and Wraparound Care Club's starting after half term – Tuesday 1st November 2022.

Breakfast Club is run each morning from 8.00am in the dining room. Children are given toast / cereals and this is priced at £1 a day.

Wraparound care is run everyday after school from 3.00pm to 5.00pm in our Nurture Bungalow and this is priced at £5 per day. Children will be offered a snack and a drink.

To book a place on either of the clubs, you will need to log onto your Arbor app. All parents have been sent their log in information. If you haven't received this you will need to contact the school office as you will be unable to book a place without it.

Here are the instructions on how to book your child a place on the Arbor app.

Please ensure you have booked your place for w.c: 31st October 2022 by 12 noon on Friday 28th October 2022 (48 hours notice is required).

Log in to your Arbor app:

From the main Parent Portal page, scroll down to the **Activities** section and click on the field with the children's name and club in. This will then list all clubs available to your child. Select the club you require.

The club information page will then display membership and timetable information.

To sign your child up to the club, click on **register for this club** in the top right-hand corner of the page.

In the slide over, choose the **membership period** to sign up for – this may be a day, week or the full term.

Check all the dates / times are correct and click **confirm registration**

You will then see confirmation of the sessions you have booked and it will also ask for payment.

Please note payment has to be made in advance to reserve a place.

As stated in the school's policy, children will not be charged if they ill or attending a school activity.

If you are unable to book a place, please contact the school office. Thank you.

School Uniform Recycle shop








<u>Christmas Fayre – 18th November 2022</u>
