Wraparound Care (After-school Childcare)

We still have availability at our After-School Club. The Club is run each day after school from 3.00pm to 5.00pm in our Nurture Bungalow. This is priced at £5 per day. Children will be offered a snack and a drink.

To book a place on the ASC, you will need to log onto your Arbor app. All parents have been sent their log in information. If you haven't received this you will need to contact the school office as you will be unable to book a place without it.

Here are the instructions on how to book your child a place on the Arbor app.

Log in to your Arbor app:

From the main Parent Portal page, scroll down to the **Activities** section and click on the field with the children's name and club in. This will then list all clubs available to your child.

Select the club you require.

The club information page will then display membership and timetable information.

To sign your child up to the club, click on **register for this club** in the top right-hand corner of the page. In the slide over, choose the **membership period** to sign up for – this may be a day, week or the full term.

Check all the dates / times are correct and click **confirm registration**

You will then see confirmation of the sessions you have booked and it will also ask for payment. **Please note payment has to be made in advance to reserve a place.**

As stated in the school's policy, children will not be charged if they ill or attending a school activity. Please contact the school office for any advice / help. Thank you
