


Extra Inset Day – Thursday 2nd November 2023

Individual School Photos – Monday 9th October 2023

Our school photographer will be in school on **Monday 9th October 2023** to do the individual photos for all children.

For anyone wishing to have sibling photos taken with siblings who are **not** in school, the photographer will be offering these from 8.30am to 8.45am in the school hall. There is no need to book, just turn up between these times. All siblings in school will automatically have photos taken together. To order photos, your child will fetch home a slip with a QR code, just scan the code to view the photos and follow the instructions on how to order. Once orders are done, the photos will be delivered to school and handed out to children to fetch home. Please note, there may be a time limit to order photos to be delivered to school. If you order after the date stated, there will be a delivery charge from the photographers.







Coats / Change of Shoes

With the colder/wetter weather approaching, could we please ask that children bring to school a coat and a change of shoes. These can be pumps or slippers but must be a full house slipper with hard soles – no slip on / novelty ones please (see below). Also, if your child plays football during lunchtime, can you please send them with some old trainers as it can be quite muddy on the field.



School Trips / Workshops

As a school, it is important for us to give the children a broad range of educational experiences which we cannot provide within school. This is why we arrange school trips/workshops each term. To be able to continue doing this, we rely heavily on the support of our parents/guardians to contribute towards the costs. The maximum contribution the school will ask for is £12 per child. (please note the school already subsidise a large majority of the costs). Unfortunately, future trips/workshops may have to be cancelled if we do not receive enough contributions from parents/guardians. Thank you for your understanding and support.

FS2 and Year 6 Height and Weight Measurement

Every year, the National Child Measurement Programme (nursing team) come into school and do height and weight measurement checks for all pupils in FS2 and year 6. The measurements are used to calculate weight status, e.g. overweight, healthy weight or underweight. They collect this information as part of an ongoing national programme to collect trends. Children are measured fully clothed, except for their coats and shoes, in a private space away from other pupils. The wellbeing of children and families is very important to us and measurements are conducted in a compassionate way, in private and away from other children. Individual results are not shared with your child or their school. Once the measurements have been taken, you will receive a text notification. If you would **not** like your child to take part then you will need to contact the **Public Health Nursing Team on 01709 423333 by 14th October 2023.** NB: Children will not be made to take part on the day if they do not want to. Parents/Guardians will be notified once the date is confirmed as to when the nursing team will be in school.

Reporting Absences

If your child is going to be absent from school, can we please remind parents/guardians to contact the school before 9.00am to let us know. If you leave a voicemail, please let us know the reason your child will be absent. As per our Attendance Policy, if we do not hear from parents/guardians by 10.30am, Mrs Sherwood and Mrs Neal will be forced to do a home visit. Thank you for your co-operation.
