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Dr Bike Session – 15th November 2023

Dear Parent/Guardian,

On the 15th November we are having a 'Dr Bike Session'

Any pupils that cycle to school will get a free health check for their bike. There are a limited number of places so make sure you book your space.

So what does that involve?

- · Every bike will be checked over to ensure that it is safe to ride
- · Bikes will have tyre pumped up and chains lubed
- Nuts and bolts will be checked for tightness
- · Brakes will be tightened and checked

But...

We are not a bike shop! In some cases we might replace some parts. But with the time and
resources we have, some things are not possible to fix

So even if you can't ride to school; push your bike in and hopefully you will be able to ride it home

<u>Children in Need – Friday 17th November 2023</u>

Children in Need will take place this year on Friday 17th November 2023. As a school we always try and support this amazing charity. Children may come to school in non-uniform for a £1 donation. We previously asked children to wear spots but we don't want to put presure on parents/guardians so we have decieved to do just a non-uniform for all. Thank you.







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FS2 and Year 6 Height and Weight Measurement

Every year, the National Child Measurement Programme (nursing team) come into school and do height and weight measurement checks for all pupils in FS2 and year 6. The measurements are used to calculate weight status, e.g. overweight, healthy weight or underweight. They collect this information as part of an ongoing national programme to collect trends. Children are measured fully clothed, except for their coats and shoes, in a private space away from other pupils. The wellbeing of children and families is very important to us and measurements are conducted in a compassionate way, in private and away from other children.

Individual results are not shared with your child or their school. Once the measurements have been taken, you will receive a text notification. If you would **not** like your child to take part then you will need to contact the **Public Health Nursing Team on 01709 423333 by 14th October 2023**. NB: Children will not be made to take part on the day if they do not want to. Parents/Guardians will be notified once the date is confirmed as to when the nursing team will be in school.

Back Gates to School (Celandine Rise Entrance)

Can we please ask that parents/guardians do not use the back gates other than during morning drop off and afternoon pick up (8.40am to 9.00am / 2.55pm to 3.10pm). Please use the main entrance during all other times. Thank you.



Reporting Absences

If you leave a voicemail, please let us know the reason why your child will be absent. Can we please ask that you don't report absences via DOJO messages.
