### **School Dinners**

Unfortunately, with the rising costs of food/fuel etc, our school lunches have risen to £2.40 per day.

A reminder to parents/guardians that school dinners must be paid for 1 week in advance using the ParentPay app/website. If your child reaches a debt over £12 they will be unable to order school dinners and a packed lunch must be brought from home until the debt is cleared.

#### **Arbor App**

A reminder to parents/guardians, that all school trips / clubs must be booked / paid for via the Arbor app/website.

You should have already received your log in information last year. New starters will have been sent this today. It is easy to set up and it also gives you access to your child's personal information. We ask that parents/guardians check this regularly and let us know if anything changes, for example: phones numbers / emergency contacts etc.

When booking a place on breakfast club, you will need to make the full payment for the whole term. This is £35 for this term (7 weeks x £5). If your child is not attending every day; you should be able to amend the amount payable. For example, if your child is only attending 2 days a week, you can change the amount payable to £14. #### **School Uniform Recycle shop**


