

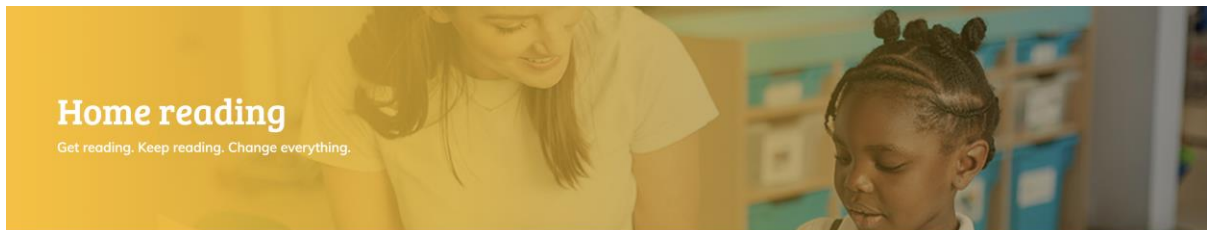
Reading stories to your child
